- Packed Lunch required



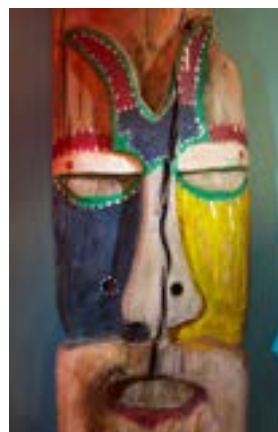
Art Trip: Brighton and Hove Museum and Pavillion
